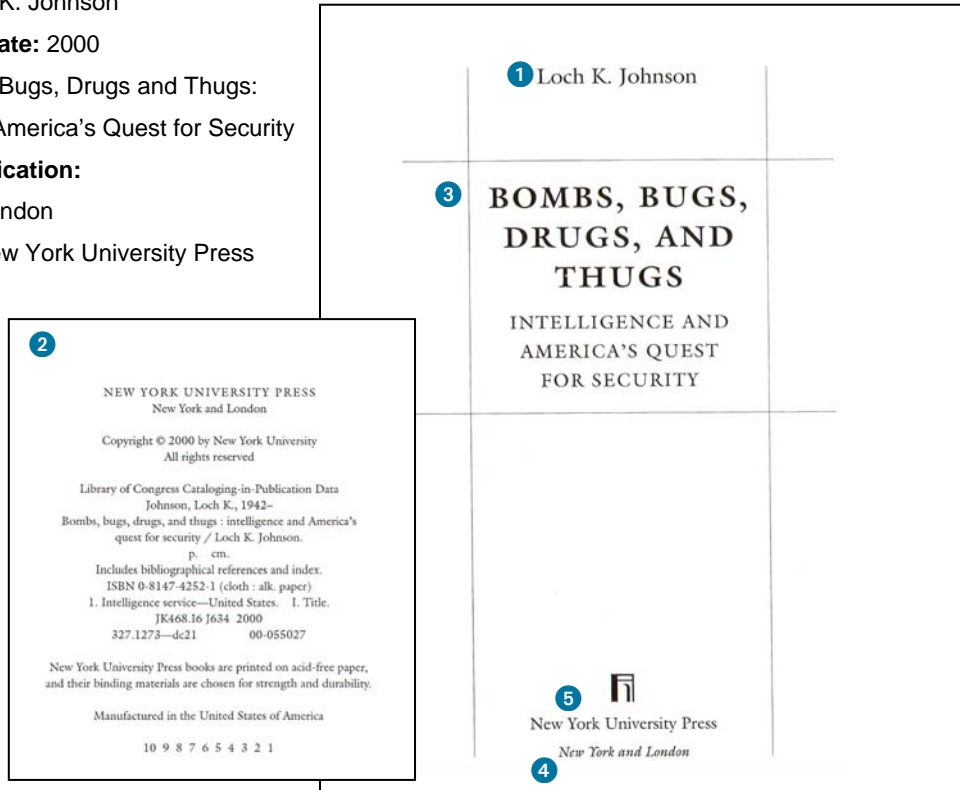


Citation Elements in order:

- ❷ **Publication date:** 2000
- ❸ **Title:** Bombs, Bugs, Drugs and Thugs: Intelligence and America's Quest for Security
- ❹ **Place of publication:** New York and London
- ❺ **Publisher:** New York University Press

Proper Bibliographic Reference Format:

Bibliographic references are single-spaced and indented after the first line:

Johnson, L. K. (2000). *Bombs, bugs, drugs and thugs: intelligence and America's quest for security*. New York and London: New York University Press.

Parenthetical Citations in Text:

Citations are placed in the context of discussion and are formatted like so, using the author's last name and the date of publication:

(Johnson, 2000)

Alternatively, you can integrate the citation into the sentence by means of narrative, like so:

Johnson (2000) addresses the issue of national security.
