- ❶ **Writers:** Richard Adler and Jerry Ross
- ❷ **Date of copyright:** 1955
- ❸ **Title of song:** Whatever Lola wants (Lola gets)
- ❹ **Recording artist:** Gwen Verdon
- ❺ **Title of album:** *Damn yankees*
- ❻ **Medium of recording:** Compact disc
- ❼ **Location:** New York
- ❽ **Label:** BMG Music
- ❾ **Recording date (if different than copyright date):** 1988

Proper Bibliographic Reference Format:

Bibliographic references are single-spaced and are indented after the first line:

Adler, R. & Ross, J. (1955). Whatever Lola wants (Lola gets) [Recorded by Gwen Verdon]. On *Damn Yankees* [CD]. New York: BMG Music. (1988)

Parenthetical Citations in Text:

Citations are placed in the context of discussion and are formatted like so, using the author's last name and the date of publication. Use both names each time you cite the item, if there are two authors:

(Adler & Ross, 1955)

Alternatively, you can integrate the citation into the sentence by means of narrative, like so:

Adler and Ross (1955) portray our national fascination with baseball.
