Proper Bibliographic Reference Format:

Bibliographical references are single-spaced and indented after the first line:

Franklin, M. (2007, July 29). Ellis bested Freud in psychology poll. *The Commercial Appeal*, p. A12. Retrieved from <http://www.pressdisplay.com/pressdisplay/viewer.aspx/>.

Parenthetical Citations in Text:

Citations are placed in the context of discussion and are formatted like so, using the author's last name and the date of publication:

(Franklin, 2007, July 29)

Alternatively, you can integrate the citation into the sentence by means of narrative, like so:

Franklin (2007, July 29) summarizes the contributions of Albert Ellis to the field of psychology.
