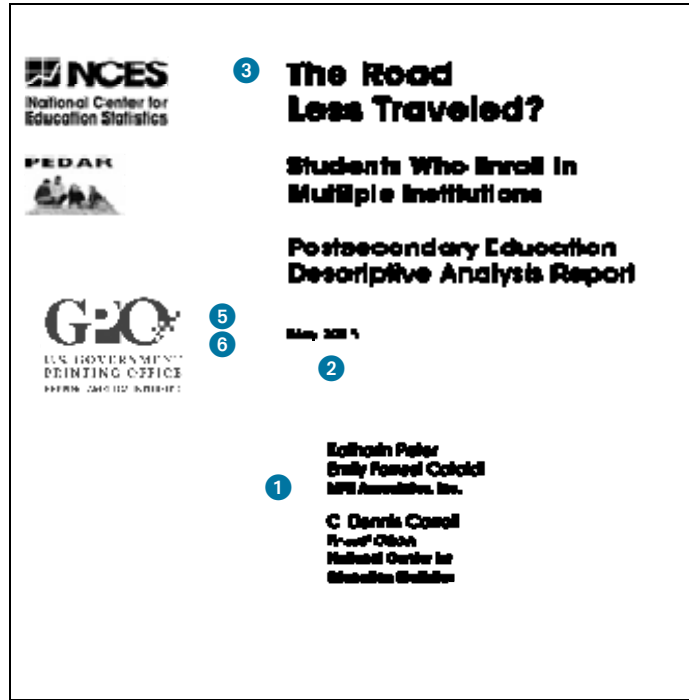

Proper Bibliographic Reference Format:

Bibliographic references are single-spaced and indented after the first line:

Peter, K., Cataldi, E. F., & Carrell, C. D. (2005). *The Road less traveled? students who enroll in multiple institutions*. (NCES 2005-157). Washington, DC: Government Printing Office.

Parenthetical Citations in Text:

Citations are placed in the context of discussion and are formatted like so, using the author's last name and the date of publication:

(Peter, Cataldi & Carrell, 2005)

Alternatively, you can integrate the citation into the sentence by means of narrative, like so:

Peter, Cataldi and Carrell (2005) discuss the predicament faced by students enrolled in multiple institutions.

Since this item has three authors, after the first citation use only the last name of the first author, with et al., as follows:

(Peter et al., 2005)

OR

Peter et al. (2005)
