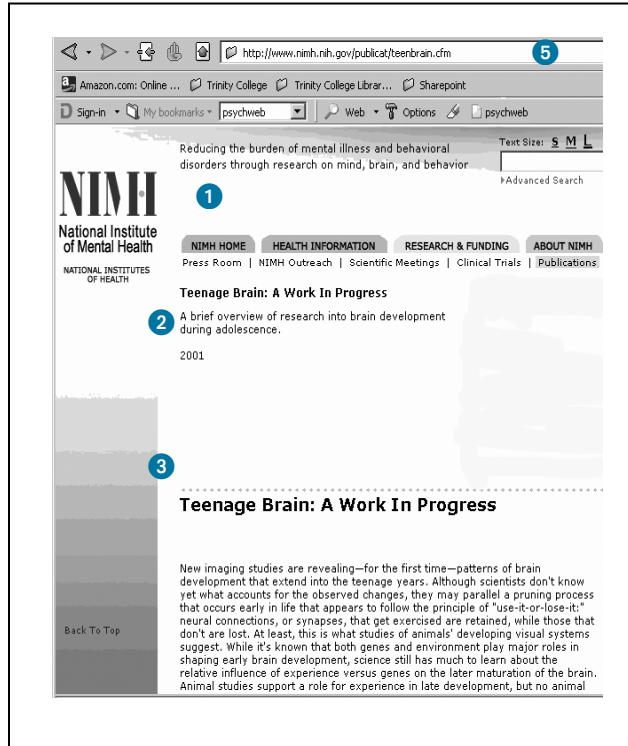

Proper Bibliographic Reference Format:

Bibliographic references are single-spaced and indented after the first line:

References in Text

Citations are placed in the context of discussion and are formatted like so, using the author's last name and the date of publication:

(National Institute of Mental Health, 2001)

Alternatively, you can integrate the citation into the sentence by means of narrative, like so:

A fact sheet by the National Institute of Mental Health (2001) describes the development of the human brain in adolescence.
