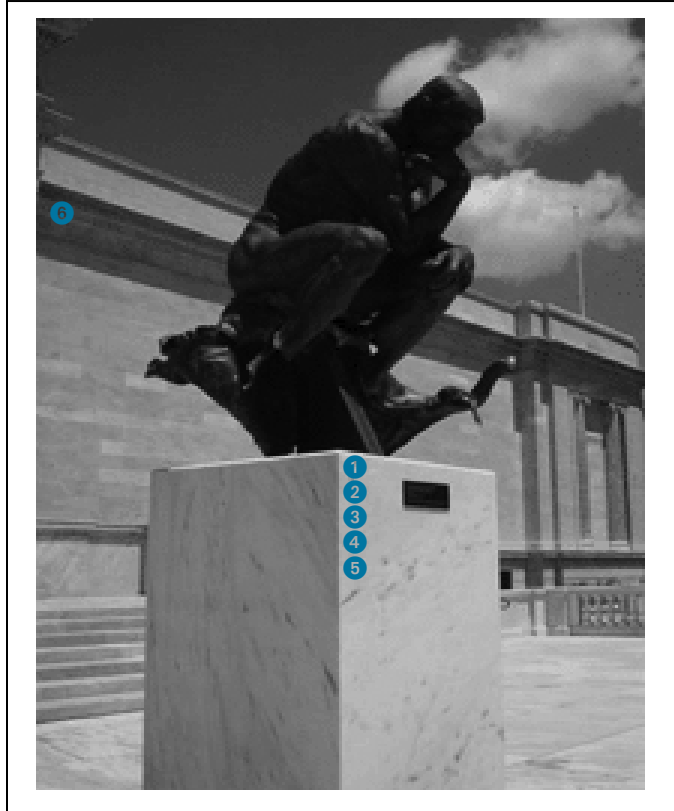
Document Example:**Proper Citation Format for Caption:**

In the caption above, the abbreviation (Fig.) is capitalized.

Reference illustrations with a parenthetical reference at the end of a sentence, including the abbreviation for figure in lower-case letters, as follows:
