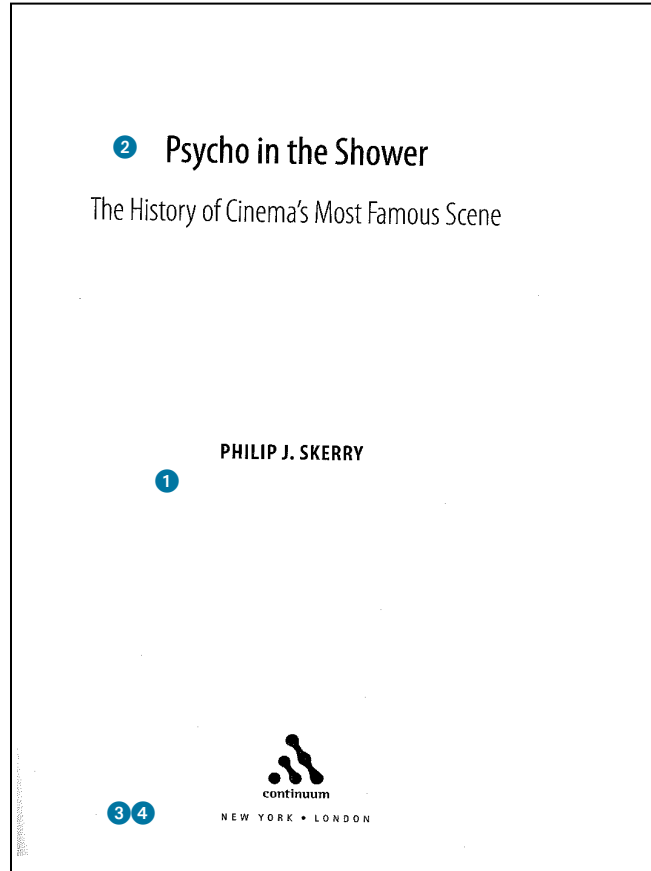


Citation Elements in order:

- ❶ **Author's name:** Philip J. Skerry
- ❷ **Book title:** *Psycho in the Shower: The History of Cinema's Most Famous Scene*
- ❸ **Place of Publication:** New York
- ❹ **Publisher:** Continuum
- ❺ **Publication date:** 2009
- ❻ **Page numbers:** 5-6, 7

Proper Bibliographic Reference Format:

Bibliographic references are single-spaced with a hanging indent after the first line, like so:

Skerry, Philip J. *Psycho in the Shower: The History of Cinema's Most Famous Scene*. New York: Continuum, 2009.

First Footnote or Endnote Citation:

The first line of the footnote or endnote is indented, and footnotes or endnotes are single-spaced:

¹Philip J. Skerry, *Psycho in the Shower: The History of Cinema's Most Famous Scene* (New York: Continuum, 2009), 5-6.

Subsequent Citations:

²Skerry, 7.

OR

²Skerry, *Psycho in the Shower*, 7.

(To distinguish from other similar authors, add a fragment of the title.)
