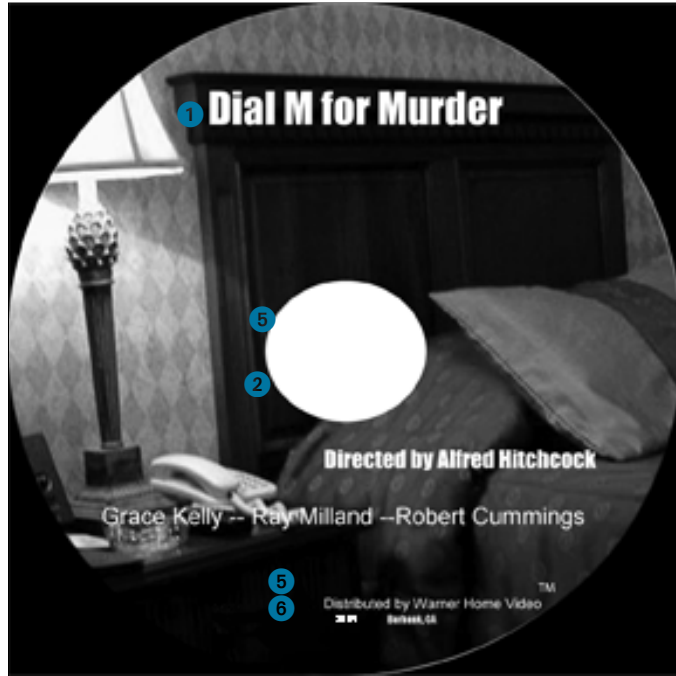


Citation Elements in order:

Proper Bibliographic Reference Format:

Bibliographic references are single-spaced with a hanging indent after the first line, like so:

Dial M for Murder. DVD. Directed by Alfred Hitchcock. 1954; Burbank, CA: Warner Home Video, 2004.

First Footnote or Endnote Citation:

The first line of the footnote or endnote is indented, and footnotes or endnotes are single-spaced:

¹*Dial M for Murder*, DVD, directed by Alfred Hitchcock (1954; Burbank, CA: Warner Home Video, 2004).

Subsequent Citations:

After the first citation, refer to the item with an abbreviated note, like so:

²*Dial M for Murder*.
