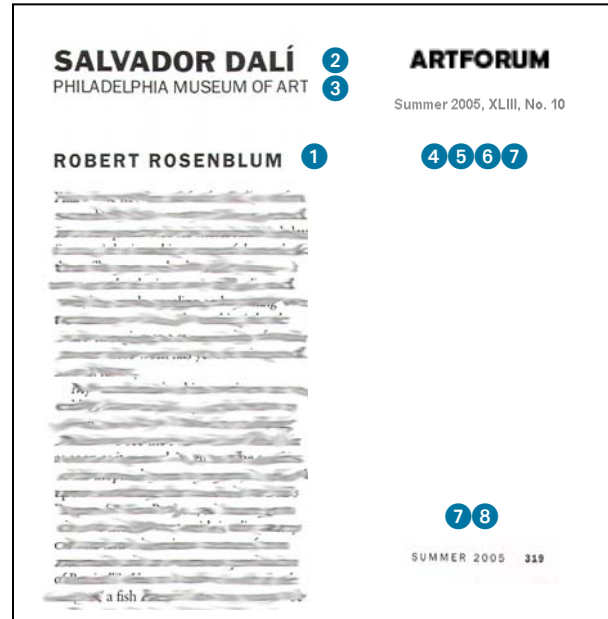

Proper Bibliographic Reference Format:

Bibliographic references are single-spaced, with a hanging indent, as follows:

Rosenblum, Robert. Review of Salvador Dalí. Philadelphia Museum of Art. *Artforum* 48, no. 10 (Summer 2005): 319-320.

First Footnote or Endnote Citation:

Footnotes or endnotes are single-spaced, and the first line is indented, as follows:

¹Robert Rosenblum, Review of Salvador Dalí, Philadelphia Museum of Art, *Artforum* 48, no. 10 (Summer 2005), 319.

Subsequent Citations:

(To distinguish from other similar authors, add a fragment of the title.)
