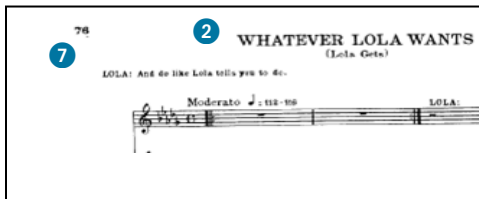
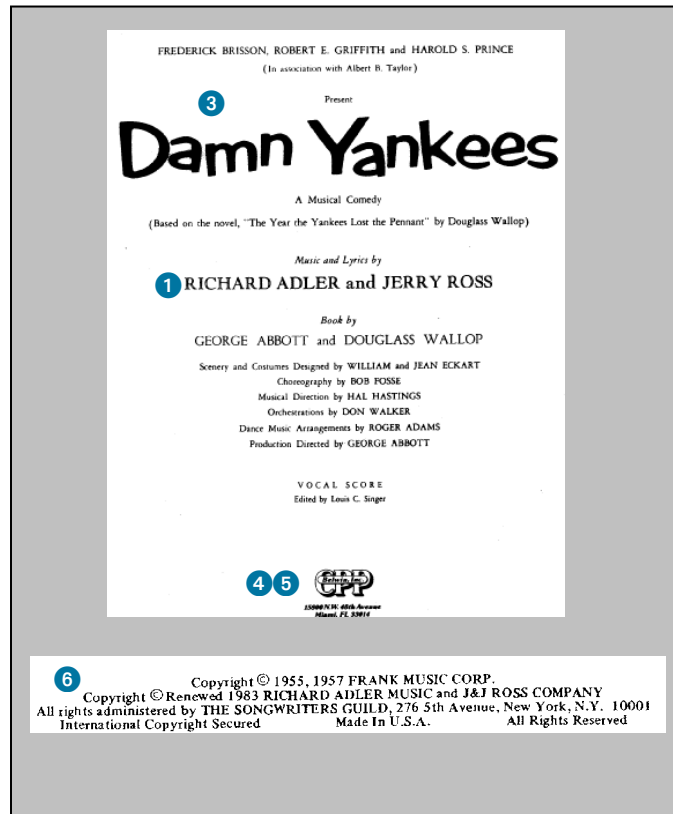

Proper Bibliographic Reference Format:

Bibliographic references are single-spaced and indented after the first line:

Adler, Richard and Jerry Ross. "Whatever Lola Wants (Lola Gets)." In *Damn Yankees*. Miami, FL: CCP Belwin, 1983: 76-81.

First Footnote or Endnote Citation:

Endnotes and footnotes are single-spaced and the first line is indented.

Use only enough information to distinguish the item from other similar items:
