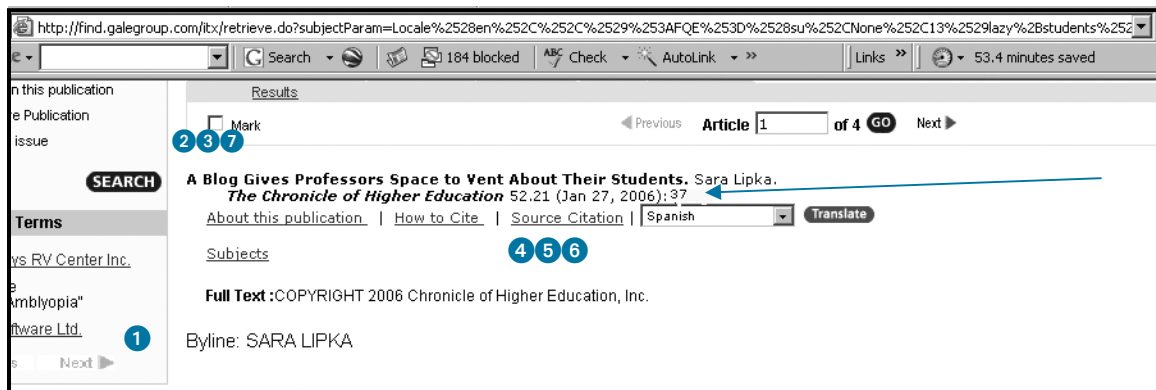

**Parenthetical Reference:**

Place parenthetical references at the ends of your sentences. Parenthetical references include the author's last name and page number. Be sure to notice that there's no comma after the author's last name:
