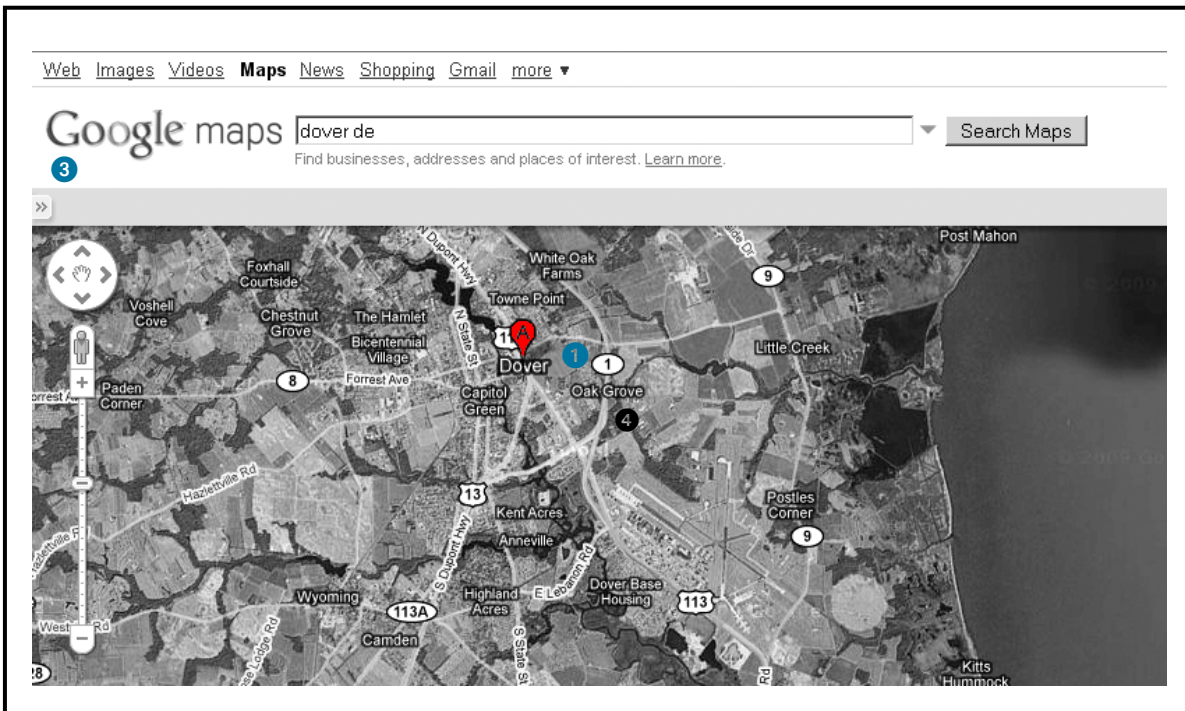

Proper Citation Format:

“Dover, Delaware.” Map. *Google Maps*. Google, 23 July 2009. Web. 23 July 2009.

Parenthetical Reference:

When citing documents that lead with a title, use the title, or part of the title, in the parenthetical reference. When using part of the title, start with the words at the beginning of the title. Put your parenthetical references at the ends of your sentences:

(“Dover, Delaware”).
