❶ **Episode or segment title:**

❷ **Pertinent personnel:** Seth McFarlane, etc. (the producers, in this case)

❸ **Name of program:** Family Guy

❹ **Publisher or sponsor:**

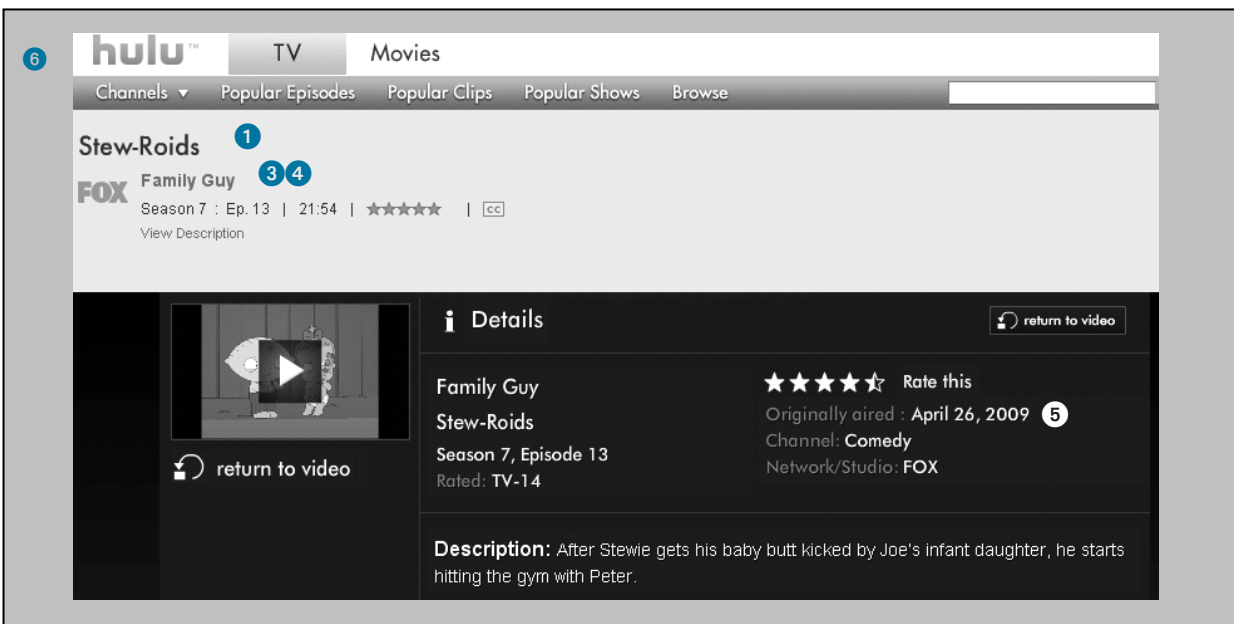

❺ **Broadcast date:** April 26, 2009

❻ **Title of Web site:** hulu

❼ **Format:** Web

❽ **Date of access:** July 23, 2009



Proper Citation Format:

“Stew-Roids.” Prod. Seth McFarlane, et al. *Family Guy*. Fox Broadcasting Company, 26 Apr. 2009. *hulu*. Web. 30 July 2009.

Parenthetical Reference:

Since there are no page numbers in a broadcast on the Web, then you don't have to include them. Lead with the title, or part of the title, using the beginning words. Put parenthetical references at the ends of your sentences:

(“Stew-Roids”).
